### Your rights and responsibilities:

- An interment right will only be granted to one interment right holder.
- The interment right holder may transfer or cancel an interment right, subject to conditions set out in Council's Cemetery policy and in accordance with the *Burial and Cremation Act 2013 and regulations*.

### Authority to exercise the interment right:

- Only the interment right holder may exercise an interment right, provided that if the interment right holder is deceased the interment right may be exercised by the personal representative of the deceased interment right holder (by definition the Executor or Administrator of the Deceased Estate) in accordance with section 35 of the *Burial and Cremation Act 2013*.
- If there is no personal representative the interment right may be exercised in accordance with regulation 32 of the *Burial and Cremation Regulations 2014* as follows:
  - a) by the spouse or domestic partner of the deceased interment right holder; or
  - b) if there is no surviving spouse or domestic partner by the eldest living relative of the deceased interment right holder, in the following descending order of priority:
    - a child;
    - a grandchild or great-grandchild;
    - a brother or sister;
    - a parent;
    - a grandparent;
    - an aunt or uncle;
    - a nephew or niece;
    - a cousin;
    - any other blood relative.
