- Morning swimming times will be allocated e.g. 6.30am to 8.00am and there will be no charge for season ticket holders. Council will provide a lifeguard (this lifeguard is not permitted to swim at the same time).
- When the pool is hired for a function and there is no Council lifeguard present, e.g. Functions, Time Trials & Carnivals, the hirer must complete the Form of Formal Instrument of Agreement for the use of Councils Swimming Pools/Recreation Facility and comply with the requirement of this Agreement.
- If private tuition is being provided for a fee at the facility, the provider must complete the Form of Formal Instrument of Agreement for the use of Councils Swimming Pools/Recreation Facility and comply with the requirement of this Agreement.
- If private tuition is being undertaken during the pool opening hours the instructor shall consult with the Pool Manager to confirm the area to be utilised for tuition. The location shall be at the discretion of the Pool Manager after considering weather conditions and pool use.
- During opening times lane ropes or divisions shall not be placed to compromise the OHS&W of the pool facility and restrict public access to both long sides of the pool i.e. Lane ropes shall only be placed on one long side of the pool during opening hours.
- No single seasons ticket will be sold to any child under 10 years of age.
- Group Seasons Tickets -all ticket holders need to all reside in the same residence.
