Asbestos	Not accepted by Council. Contract your licenced asbestos removal firm.	Naracoorte Transfer Station. For more information contact Naracoorte Lucindale Council : www.naracoortelucindale.sa.gov.au
Engine Oil (domestic quantities)	Deliver to waste oil facilities at Bordertown Transfer Station.	There are waste oil facilities at Bordertown Transfer Station.
Engine Oil (commercial/large quantities)	No more than 1000 l at any one time per person. Prior arrangement needs to be organised with Transfer Station Operator before bringing in large quantities.	Commercial/larger quantities of engine oil can be organised through: National Oil – who visit the South East several times a year and collect waste oil free of charge. Phone (08) 8374 2092. E-Waste	Personal & laptop computers and all cables, tablets, notebooks, palmbooks, computer monitors and parts (eg. internal hard drives and CD drives), computer peripherals and accessories eg. mice, keyboards, web cameras, USB's and modems, printers, faxes, scanners and multi-functional devices, televisions	<image/>
Fridges, Stoves & Whitegoods	Accepted at Bordertown and Keith Transfer Station Fridge, freezer, air conditioner, fees apply. Must be degassed.	Local Scrap Metal Dealer: Bordertown or Keith Recycling Depot
Green Organic Waste (Non Commercial Loads Only)	Must be clean of any contaminants. Accepted at Bordertown and Keith Transfer Stations. No charge.	
General Household Waste	Accepted at all sites. Please segregate all waste into recyclable and waste bins	General Household waste includes waste you would deposit in your red bin.

Hardwaste (cleanfill)	Domestic quantities of clay, gravel, sand, soil and rock that is not mixed with any other waste can be delivered to Bordertown and Keith.	Commercial inert materials accepted at Bordertown at POA.
Hazardous Chemicals	Not accepted at any of Council's sites.	Ring local waste management companies for advice eg. Cleanaway (08) 8725 3500. Bin It (08) 8724 8121.
Lounge Suites	Break down into components such as timber, material and springs and place into separate recycling and waste bins at all of Council's sites. Charges apply if you are not willing to pull apart yourself.	
LPG Gas Cylinders	Gas cylinders are accepted at cost but must not contain any gas and must have valve removed. Use "Swap & Go" when possible.	
Mattresses	Remove padding from springs. Springs can be recycled as scrap metal and the material And padding as household waste (no charge). Accepted at all of Council's sites. Charges apply if you are not willing to pull apart yourself.	

Paint	Liquid paint is not accepted. Solidified pain can be treated as household waste and accepted at all of Council's Waste Transfer Stations (ie. Remove solidified paint from tin and place in red bin, clean paint tin into the yellow bin)	Dulux and Wattyl have developed pain hardener products that solidify pain. You can also solidify paint by mixing it with clay-based kitty litter.
Refrigerant Cylinders	Will be accepted at Bordertown and Keith but must be degassed and valves removed. Cost applies.	Bin It, Mount Gambier will accept fridges for degasing. Phone: (08) 8724 8121.
Steel/metal	Can deposit at any of Council's Waste Transfer Station sites.	Bordertown or Keith Recycling Depot.
Timber	Untreated timber, tree branches, are accepted as "green waste", provided the load is not contaminated with metal bolts, steel plates etc.	
Treated Timber, inc. CCA, Creosote	There is currently no recycling arrangement for treated timber. Treated timber cannot be deposited in landfill. Recommended to store until disposing method is developed.
